GUIDE TO OBTAINING A WORK PERMIT FOR FOREIGN **EMPLOYEES IN VIETNAM - 2025**

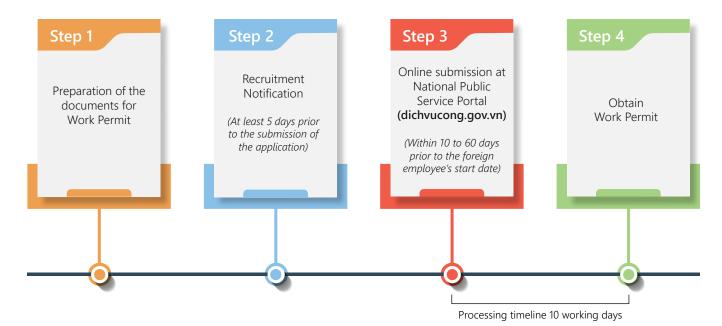


A Work Permit is an official document issued by the Vietnamese authorities, granting permission to a foreign employee to lawfully work in Vietnam for a specific employer. It also serves as proof of the employee's lawful rights and interests in labor relations under Vietnamese law.

Pursuant to Decree No. 219/2025/ND-CP ("Decree 219"), which introduced new regulations on foreign employees in Vietnam and took effect on 7 August 2025, the procedures for obtaining a Work Permit are as follows:

I. Newly issued Work Permits

For cases where foreign employees intend to legally work and carry out employment activities in Vietnam.



Required document

- 1. Application form completed by the employer.
- 2. Health certificate: Issued by a qualified medical examination and treatment establishment; no hard copy required if results are available on the Health Examination and Treatment Management Information System or the National Health database (remains valid within 12 months).
- 3. Valid passport.
- 4. Criminal record certificate (Issued within 6 months).
- 5. Color photograph (size 4 cm x 6 cm), white background, full-face, bareheaded, without glasses: 2 photographs.
- 6. Documents proving form of employment (on a case-by-case basis): As stated in Clause 6 Article 18 Decree No. 219.
- 7. Document proving the foreign employee's role as a manager, a chief executive officer, an expert, or a technical worker (on a case-by-case basis): As stated in Article 19 Decree No. 219.
- * Validity: A maximum of 2 years.

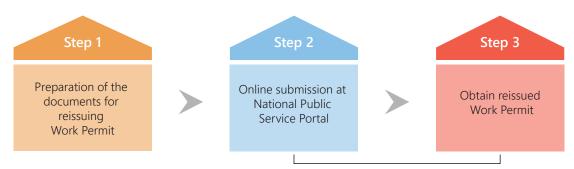




II. Reissuing Work Permits

For cases where:

- Lost or damaged unexpired Work Permits.
- Updates to information on an unexpired Work Permit: the employee's name, nationality, passport number, or employer's name (without changing the employer's registration number).



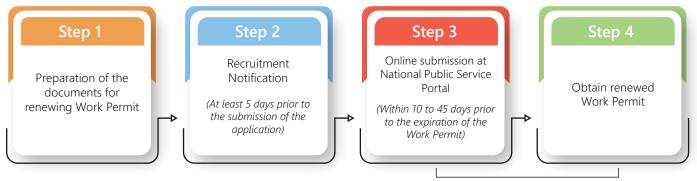
Processing timeline 3 working days

Required document

- 1. Application form completed by the employer.
- 2. Color photograph (size 4 cm x 6 cm), white background, full-face, bareheaded, without glasses: 2 photographs.
- 3. Documents proving the changed content: The employee's name, nationality, passport number, or employer's name (without changing the employer's registration number).
- 4. The unexpired work permit, except in cases where lost.
- * Validity: Equal to the remaining period of the original work permit, less the time already worked.

III. Renewing Work Permits

For cases where a foreign employee wishes to continue working legally and carrying out professional activities in Vietnam.



Processing timeline 10 working days

Required document

- 1. Application form completed by the employer.
- 2. Health certificate: Issued by a qualified medical examination and treatment establishment; no hard copy required if results are available on the Health Examination and Treatment Management Information System or the National Health database (remains valid within 12 months).
- 3. Valid passport.
- 4. Color photograph (size 4 cm x 6 cm), white background, full-face, bareheaded, without glasses: 2 photographs.
- 5. An existing Work Permit that remains valid.
- 6. Documents proving form of employment (on a case-by-case basis): As stated in Clause 6 Article 27 Decree No. 219.

*Validity: Can only be renewed once, with a maximum validity of 2 years.
